These 15 marvelous results of justification happen the **instant** we are saved. They are found in Romans 5:1-11.

| 1.  | Rom.5:1  | <i>"we have peace with God"</i>                    | Because. nothing is <b>now</b> between us and God.                                                                       |
| 2.  | Rom.5:2  | <i>"by whom"</i>                                   | That is, by Christ our advocate; our go-between.                                                                         |
| 3.  | Rom.5:2  | <i>"we have access by faith"</i>                   | Our admittance into the very presence of God.                                                                            |
| 4.  | Rom.5:2  | <i>"into this grace"</i>                           | From the new birth and throughout eternity.                                                                              |
| 5.  | Rom.5:2  | <i>"wherein we stand"</i>                          | A perfect standing which never changes!                                                                                  |
| 6.  | Rom.5:2  | <i>"and rejoice"</i>                               | For sins forgiven, as all our sins were atoned for at Calvary.                                                           |
| 7.  | Rom.5:2  | <i>"in hope"</i>                                   | The hope that does not fade away throughout eternity.                                                                    |
| 8.  | Rom.5:2  | <i>"the glory of God."</i>                         | Awaits us on the other side.                                                                                             |
| 9.  | Rom.5:5  | <i>"not ashamed"</i>                               | Because our sins forgiven and we are justified in God's sight.                                                           |
| 10. | Rom.5:5  | <i>"love of God is shed abroad in our hearts."</i> | Now, we love God and his people.                                                                                         |
| 11. | Rom.5:5  | <i>"by the holy ghost which is given unto us"</i>  | Though the Holy Ghost is given to all believers, yet all have not accepted Him (been infilled with evidence of tongues). |
| 12. | Rom.5:9  | <i>"saved from wrath through him"</i>              | Saved from eternal wrath by Christ.                                                                                      |
| 13. | Rom.5:10 | <i>"reconciled to God"</i>                         | Now, there is nothing between God and us now.                                                                            |
| 14. | Rom.5:10 | <i>"shall be saved by his life"</i>                | Not by our life but by His.                                                                                              |
| 15. | Rom.5:11 | <i>"we have now received the atonement"</i>        | Here, the Greek translation for " <i>atonement</i> " is <b>RECONCILIATION.</b>                                           |
