## "Walking" in Ephesians

Ephesians 2:2-4	<sup>2</sup> Wherein <i>in time past ye</i> walked <i>according to the course of this world</i> , according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience: <sup>3</sup> But fornication, and all uncleanness, or covetousness, let it not be once named among you, as becometh saints; <sup>4</sup> Neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor jesting, which are not convenient: but rather giving of thanks.
Ephesians 2:10	For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus <i>unto good works</i> , which God hath before ordained {prepared} that we should walk in them.
Ephesians 4:1	I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord {in the Lord}, beseech you that ye walk worthy of the vocation wherewith ye are called,
Ephesians 4:17- 18,22-24	<sup>17</sup> This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that ye henceforth walk not as other Gentiles walk, in the vanity of their mind, <sup>18</sup> Having the understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness {hardness} of their heart. <sup>22</sup> That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; <sup>23</sup> And be renewed in the spirit of your mind; <sup>24</sup> And that ye put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness {holiness of truth}.
Ephesians 5:2	And walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling savour.
Ephesians 5:8	For ye were sometimes darkness, but now are ye light in the Lord: walk as children of light:
Ephesians 5:15-21	Ephesians 5:16-21 KJV <sup>16</sup> Redeeming the time, because the days are evil. <sup>17</sup> Wherefore be ye not unwise, but understanding what the will of the Lord is. <sup>18</sup> And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit; <sup>19</sup> Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord; <sup>20</sup> Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ; <sup>21</sup> Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God.
