“Walking” in Ephesians

Ephesians 2:2-4	² Wherein <i>in time past ye walked according to the course of this world</i> , according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience: ³ But fornication, and all uncleanness, or covetousness, let it not be once named among you, as becometh saints; ⁴ Neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor jesting, which are not convenient: but rather giving of thanks.
Ephesians 2:10	For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus <i>unto good works</i> , which God hath before ordained {prepared} that we should <i>walk in them</i> .
Ephesians 4:1	I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord {in the Lord} , beseech you that ye <i>walk worthy of the vocation wherewith ye are called</i> ,
Ephesians 4:17-18,22-24	¹⁷ This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that ye henceforth <i>walk not as other Gentiles walk, in the vanity of their mind</i> , ¹⁸ Having the understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness {hardness} of their heart. ²² That <i>ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man</i> , which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; ²³ And <i>be renewed in the spirit of your mind</i> ; ²⁴ And that <i>ye put on the new man</i> , which after God is created in righteousness and true holiness {holiness of truth} .
Ephesians 5:2	And <i>walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us</i> , and hath given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling savour.
Ephesians 5:8	For ye were sometimes darkness, but now are ye light in the Lord: <i>walk as children of light</i> :
Ephesians 5:15-21	¹⁵ See then that ye <i>walk circumspectly, not as fools, but as wise</i> , Ephesians 5:16-21 KJV ¹⁶ <i>Redeeming the time</i> , because the days are evil. ¹⁷ Wherefore be ye not unwise, but <i>understanding what the will of the Lord is</i> . ¹⁸ And <i>be not drunk with wine</i> , wherein is excess; <i>but be filled with the Spirit</i> ; ¹⁹ <i>Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord</i> ; ²⁰ <i>Giving thanks always for all things</i> unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ; ²¹ <i>Submitting yourselves one to another</i> in the fear of God.
