The 12 Engraved Stones

THE BREASTPLATE, Exo. 28&39

Exo.28:5-6 — The breastplate was a piece of elaborately finished cloth of the same material as the ephod. It was a strip twice as long as it was wide ("a span [9"] long and a span [9"] wide, doubled" [Exo.39:9]), but folded back on itself so as to form a square bag into which the Urim and Thummim¹ were placed.

THE 12 STONES, Exo. 28 & 39

The breastplate's engraved precious stones represent the 12 tribes of Israel, and they were to be borne before the Lord continually as a memorial. Each stone, engraved like a "signet" [Exo.39:14] (raised off the face of the stone) would have been placed on the Breastplate by order of "birth", oldest to youngest (see table at end of this handout).

The Bible gives no exact dimensions for each stone; however, a rough estimate of 3"L x 2.25"H can be arrived at by dividing the 9" width by 3 ("3 in a row") and then divide the 9" length by 4 ("set in gold in 4 rows").

Since the days of the Alexandrian translators of the Old Testament it has been asserted that Urim and Thummim mean "revelation and truth" or "lights and perfections"). One or the other could be drawn from the Breastplate's pouch in order to provide a "Yes" or "No" answer when seeking the LORD for guidance. [JEWISH DICTIONARY]
