12 Gates (Nehemiah 3 & 12)

NEHEMIAH 3:1-31, GATES 1-10

Gate 1 — ¹ Then Eliashib the high priest rose up with his brethren the priests, and they builded the **sheep gate**; they sanctified it, and set up the doors of it; even unto the tower of Meah they sanctified it, unto the tower of Hananeel.

Gate 2 — ³ But the **fish gate** did the sons of Hassenaah build, who also laid the beams thereof, and set up the doors thereof, the locks thereof, and the bars thereof.

Gate 3 — ⁶ Moreover the **old gate** repaired Jehoiada the son of Paseah, and Meshullam the son of Besodeiah; they laid the beams thereof, and set up the doors thereof, and the locks thereof, and the bars thereof.

Gate 4 — ¹³ The **valley gate** repaired Hanun, and the inhabitants of Zanoah; they built it, and set up the doors thereof, the locks thereof, and the bars thereof...

Gate 5 — ¹⁴ But the **dung gate** repaired Malchiah the son of Rechab, the ruler of part of Bethhaccerem; he built it, and set up the doors thereof, the locks thereof, and the bars thereof.

Gate 6 — ¹⁵ But the **gate of the fountain** repaired Shallun the son of Colhozeh, the ruler of part of Mizpah; he built it, and covered it, and set up the doors thereof, the locks thereof, and the bars thereof...

Gate 7 — ²⁶ Moreover the Nethinims dwelt in Ophel, unto the place over against the **water gate** toward the east, and the tower that lieth out.

Gate 8 — ²⁸ From above the **horse gate** repaired the priests, every one over against his house.

Gate 9 — ²⁹ After them repaired Zadok the son of Immer over against his house. After him repaired also Shemaiah the son of Shechaniah, the keeper of the **east gate**.

Gate 10 — ³¹ After him repaired Malchiah the goldsmith's son unto the place of the Nethinims, and of the merchants, over against the **gate Miphkad**, and to the going up of the corner.

NEHEMIAH 12:39, GATES 11 & 12

Gate 11 — ³⁹ And from above the **gate of Ephraim**, and above the old gate, and above the fish gate, and the tower of Hananeel, and the tower of Meah, even unto the sheep gate...

Gate 12 — ...and they stood still in the **prison gate**.
