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**About J. B. Jackson**

<sup>1</sup>John Brinckerhoff Jackson (known as “Brinck”), was born in France of wealthy parents who traveled a lot. He grew up in the Maryland suburbs of Washington and in New York City and attended private schools in Europe and the United States. As an Army combat intelligence officer in Europe in World War II, he began thinking about landscape as, in part, a human artifact and developing the idea that landscapes have styles of their own. After earning a bachelor's degree in history at Harvard University in 1932, he briefly studied architecture at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. As a writer, his cultural interpretations of the American landscape encompassed parking lots, trailer camps and highways. For nearly 50 years he roamed the nation, surveying field and forest but also registering the change wrought by human beings, regarding it as a kind of language (Brinck died at the age of 86 in 1996).

After the war he returned to the United States intending to run a ranch near Santa Fe that was left to him by an uncle, but an accident on a horse put him in the hospital for a year. In 1951 he founded *Landscape* and was its editor and publisher until 1968. It expressed the vision of a philosopher-tourist and offered an idiosyncratic blend of history, urban planning, landscape architecture, geography, anthropology and historic preservation.

<sup>2</sup>During his pursuit of studying the Bible, Brinck reached a portion which consisted largely of Proper Names, and at once he was confronted with the fact, that a considerable and, to him, important portion of the Bible was untranslated. Fully persuaded that “*whatsoever things were written aforetime were written for our learning,*” and that “*all Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine*” [Rom.15:4, 2Tim.3:16]; and hence that there could be no idle word in God’s Book; he set about preparing an accurate, alphabetical list of all the Proper Names of the Old and New Testaments with a view to securing the best possible renderings of the same.

Fortunately, there was ready access to the works of Cruden, Long, Oliver, Young, Wilkinson, Charnock, McClintock & Strong, Smith’s Bible Dictionary, Abbott’s Dictionary, Imperial Bible Dictionary, Encyclopaedia Biblica, and, before the list was complete, Strong’s Concordance, Tregelles, F. W. Grant, and others.

At the end of about 3 years, the writer had obtained a meaning for nearly every proper name in the Bible, and, on the recommendation of friends, began preparations for publishing the results of his labors for the benefit of others similarly interested. At the end of this part of his work, before he went to press, it occurred to him to experiment with some of the meanings he had secured in order to see how they would work in of those passages which had first suggested the need of his research. The result was as perplexing as it was curious; in some cases no less than 12 different, not to say opposite, meanings were given to the same name by the same writer. It was important to Brinck to determine which, if any one of them, was the English equivalent of the Hebrew or Greek name. He subjected a few of names to rigid, etymological analysis during which two discoveries were made, (1) not one of these onomasticographers could be depended upon throughout his whole list of names and (2) “every Scripture was God-inspired...that the man of God may be perfect, fully fitted to every good work.” (2 Tim. 3:16-17 – literal rendering).

He made a new start; all meanings were discarded and each name was traced to its own roots in the original tongue and the meaning derived according to the etymological rules and usage of the language in which it was written. In the present work all current authorities have been used or consulted, such as Robinson's Gesenius, Fuerst's Hebrew Lexicon, Davidson's Hebrew and Chaldee Lexicon, Hebrew and Chaldee Lexicon by Brown, Driver & Briggs as well as Tregelles and some others for portions. For the New Testament names, the Greek Lexicons of Liddell & Scott and Parkhurst have been mainly relied upon. The one controlling idea in the preparation of this work has been to provide the English-speaking reader with an exact, literal equivalent of the original Hebrew, Chaldee (Aramaic), or Greek name, and this the reader may expect to find.

2. In Hebrew proper names, **G** is hard before *e*, *i* and *y*, as "**G**ideon," "**G**ibeah"; except "**B**ethpage," which, having passed through the Greek tongue of the New Testament is subject to the rule applying to words from the Greek, whence "**B**eth phage" (as in "**c**age").
3. The diphthong **ei** is pronounced like **ee** "**K**eilah" (Kee'lah). When **ei** is followed by a vowel, the **i** is usually sounded like the *y* consonant: as Iphideiah (If e de' yah); the termination **iah**, in Old Testament names, nearly always taking that sound from the coalescing of the two Bounds "**ee**" and "**ah**" = "**yah**."
4. The consonants **c**, **s**, and **t**, before **ia** and **iu**, preceded by the accent, in most Scripture names, take the sound of "**sh**" (zh): as Cappadoc**ia**, (sha), Galat**ia** (sha), Asia (zha), Tert**ius** (shus).
